



GOAL: INVITE 800K+ PEOPLE TO MEET JESUS ACROSS AFRICA

Africa, as a continent, presents both a fascinating and daunting situation.

Fascinating because it's projected that, just 25 years from now, half of the planet's population will live on this continent. Forty percent of the globe's adults aged 18 and older will

reside in African cities, and many of them have not even been born yet.

Daunting because such massive population growth has led economists to estimate that over 450 million new jobs will need to be created. Unemployment numbers today are already staggering. Since 2018, over 4,000,000 people in Africa have been given the opportunity to meet Jesus.

In addition to the overwhelming numbers, being a Christian in Africa can be incredibly challenging. Depending on where one is on the continent, believers may face extreme poverty, violence, unrest, or even civil war. Many countries, particularly in the north, have strong ties to Islam, increasing the

threat of persecution. In southern regions, civil unrest often leads to violence, and calls for peace can be met with beatings.

If our efforts relied only on human strength, the task would feel hopeless. But praise be to God—He is in control. Our indigenous partners know exactly how to reach their fellow countrymen, leading with the Word of God and spreading an infectious Gospel hope.

By God's grace, we are reaching people in every country through digital and print means, or both. For example, 7% of Libya's population has the League's Gospel of John on their phones. Through our partners, we support on-the-ground evangelism and discipleship in 30 of Africa's 54 countries.

Our goal is to invite 800,000 people across Africa to meet Jesus by September 2025. **Since 2019, over 4.4 million people have been given the opportunity to meet Jesus through our Strategic Partners.** By continuing to work with these indigenous teams, our goal is to invite between 800,000 and 1 million people across Africa to meet Jesus by September 2025.

Achieving this will require \$200,000 in funding. For just \$0.20 per person, someone can engage with the Word of God and meet Jesus.

How is this so cost-effective? The Pocket Testament League has been mobilizing and equipping Christians to Read, Carry, and Share[®] the Word of

God since 1893. By leveraging our extensive network of volunteers, we can minimize program costs, ensuring that nearly all funds go directly toward printing, shipping, and distributing Gospels of John in the field.

A grant of \$50,000 would allow a quarter of a million people to be invited to meet Jesus.
