THE CHALLENGE

Each day, the "thumbscrews get turned a little more." Chinese Christians face continually increasing government pressure, new laws, new interpretations, and new zeal from those seeking to eliminate the name of Jesus.

More and more, Pastors are imprisoned and churches shutdown.

These actions do not deter Jesus' followers. For years when we were able to visit China, one of their main expectations was increased persecution.

THE OPPORTUNITY

In the Old Testament, God provided Daniel, a righteous man, to serve an evil emperor. Today in China, there are a number of "Daniels" – Godly men whom God has placed inside the government.

They have the authority to legally print Gospels of John and then, through various networks, invite people in China to meet Jesus.

Today we raise support both inside and outside China.

Surveillance... Restrictions... Reporting... Imprisonment...

Each day there are more and more restrictions.

Since 2009, more than 19.6 million people have been offered an opportunity to meet Jesus with a Gospel of John.

HEALING HANDS AND OPEN HEARTS

Sister Cai from Shanghai has been a devoted Member of The Pocket Testament League for eight years, bringing the Gospel of John to countless people seeking hope.

Her team has a simple yet profound mission: offer free auricular plaster therapy in public spaces and use this as an opportunity to share the Gospel. The therapy drew people in and, as they received care, Sister Cai and her team gently introduced them to the message of Jesus. Despite the challenges of working in an area with strict government controls and limited resources, their dedication shone through.

Over 4 ½ months, they reached 2,000 people with the Gospel, sharing 1,200 Gospels of John with the spiritually hungry. The result: God worked in their hearts through His Word, leading 370 individuals to make a decision for Christ. Sister Cai's team offered countless heartfelt prayers for those they met. They moved from village to village, working with different coworkers in three phases, training new members along the way.

"God's hand of grace was with us," Sister Cai shared. "Even the stones must praise His greatness, and His miraculous power is with us!"

Through many seeds planted in peoples' hearts, combined with the quiet persistence of prayer, they witnessed God's transformative power at work in the lives of many, proving that even in the most remote places His Word never returns void.
